"3. Death of driver

What we cover

If you or the authorised driver of your vehicle sustains a fatal injury during an event covered under Part 1 during the period of insurance, we will pay:

*\$5,000 to the estate of the deceased person; and

*up to \$5,000 for any one (1) event for travel costs within Australia and its external territories for members of the deceased driver's immediate family to attend the deceased driver's funeral. This benefit will not be reduced by any accident compensation.

What we exclude

We will not pay:

*any claim if the death happens:

* more than 12 months from the date of the event; or

* because the driver committed suicide

*any claim if we have paid an amount under Extra Cover 4 - 'Personal

accident' in respect of the same driver."
